God has called us to share life with Him. Jesus, in John 17, talks about the shared life He has with the Father. He then says, "May they also be in us, so that the world may believe you sent me." (John 17:21)

John would go on to write how our fellowship (sharing life together) comes as we have fellowship with God (see 1 John 1:3). Just as children are related to each other be cause they share the same parent, if we are God's children, then we are connected to each other because we have God as our Father. This is the reality for us who believe in Jesus (John 1:12), we become children of God.

So how do we share life together?

We all have God as our Father

We all have Jesus as our Saviour

We have all received the same Holy Spirit

(I could go on—there is more in Ephesians 4:4-6).

This is what we share when we come together, it is this life in Christ that we are encouraged to stir up in each other (Hebrews 10:24-25). It is this life in Christ that shapes our we live with one another.



You have a message ...

We are used to having notifications on our mobile devices that tell us about messages, posts, voicemails, things that we have either missed, or that various apps have decided we need to be told about. We live in a world that constantly seeks to give us what it thinks we want.

God, in His wisdom, waits for us to *seek Him*. He is waiting for us to *turn towards Him*. Just like Moses who saw the burning bush, stopped, and went to look—then God spoke (you can read about it in Exodus 3:3-4).

God, in His wisdom, is waiting for us to *seek Him*. To stop for a few moments and *turn towards Him*, and listen for His voice. How does God speak? He speaks though His Word.

Josiah is a great example (read about it in 2 Chronicles 34:14-21): when he heard what was written in God's Word, so his heart was touched, and he knew God was speaking to him.

God, in His wisdom, is waiting for us to *seek Him*, so He can speak to us. To stop, open up His Word, and *listen*.

We have suggested a chapter a day (see right hand side of this page) for you to open, read, and listen. Is there an example that is relevant to your situation? A phrase of sentence that catches your attention? Listen for the gentle prompting of the Holy Spirit as He *speaks*.

Remember, God does not shout, He is not in the storm, the loud noise, but in the quiet, in the whisper (read about Elijah's encounter with God in 1 Kings 19:10-13). To hear God's whisper you have to lean in close, and listen.
