WHO IS JESUS?

"He is the image of the invisible God, the firstborn over all creation.

For everything was created by him, in heaven and on earth, the visible and the invisible. whether thrones or dominions or rulers or authoritiesall things have been created through him and for him. He is before all things, and by him all things hold together. He is also the head of the body, the church; he is the beginning, the firstborn from the dead, so that he might come to have first place in everything. For God was pleased to have all his fullness dwell in him, and through him to reconcile everything to himself, whether things on earth or things in heaven,

by making peace through his blood, shed on the cross.

JESUS IS LORD

I wonder how you would answer the question, "Who is Jesus?"

Many people have explored this question. Maybe you have read about this search from CS Lewis, Josh McDowell, Lee Strobel or J Warner Wallace? (Look them up if you want you know more.)

As we read through the New Testament we can find many different ways that Jesus is described. He is described as Christ, as Lord, as Saviour, as Son of God and as Son of Man.

In a conversation with His disciples in Matthew 16, Jesus made the question personal and asked, "who do you say that I am?" This is perhaps the key question: who is Jesus to you? What place does Jesus have in your life?

Jesus calls us to personal response: knowing about Jesus is one thing, our acceptance of who He is for us, in our lives, is what Jesus is interested in.

Today the question is not, "Is Jesus Lord?", but rather, "Is He *your* Lord, *your* Saviour?"

Therefore let all the house of Israel know with certainty that God has made this Jesus, whom you crucified, both Lord and Messiah. (Acts 2:36)

WILL YOU READ WITH US?

If you have been reading with us on our journey through the New Testament, then by the end of this month we will have read over half of the New Testament. I hope you are feeling encouraged.

We are now reading through the letters that were written to the early churches. There will be some very familiar verses and sayings in these readings, and they may well remind you of promises from God, and encouragement you have received in the past. As we read through the letters to the churches in Rome and Corinth, may God speak to us in new and fresh ways.

How has God been speaking to you?

As you reflect on what you have read in the New Testament, what has stood out to you? What has the Holy Spirit drawn your attention to, highlighted for you to remember?

Did you make a note? Maybe in a journal?

It can be very helpful to write something down in a journal or notebook so you can look back and see how God has been leading you in your journey so far. Have a go and see how you get on.
