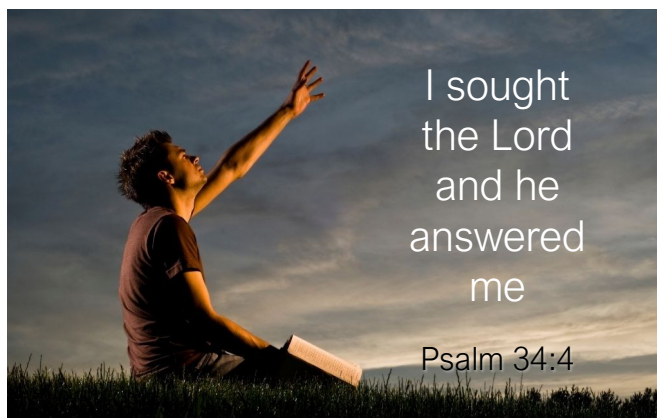

With our faith in Christ we will see the Kingdom of God, and finally have peace.

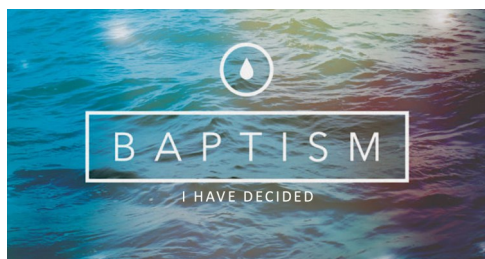
We should remind ourselves that when we stray from the path, there are still better things to come.

## Growing in Grace

In Matthew 6:21-35 Jesus tells a parable. None of us want to be like the man identified as “unforgiving”, we would like to think we are better than this. Yet we are also warned “do not receive the grace of God in vain.” (2 Corinthians 6:1)

Grace is received from God, by which we discover God loves us, God has provided atonement and forgiveness of our sin, and God offers us life and freedom. As people who *receive* grace, we are also called to be people who *show* grace; we forgive as we have been forgiven, we love because we are loved by God.

This is what it means to become like Jesus, who was “full of grace” (John 1:14).

How are we living this out in our lives? Are your words marked with grace? Do others think of you as someone who is gracious in the way they treat others?
